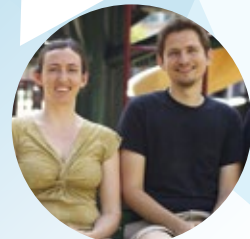

Revitalizing FilmScene's Scene 1 Cinema

What began as a dream to return movie magic to downtown Iowa City is now a beloved home for film.

This campaign includes support for the renovation of FilmScene's Scene 1 cinema, new seating, lobby improvements, and maintaining modern presentation standards.

Our reputation for excellence is built on diverse and distinguished art, dedicated patronage, and a rewarding audience experience.

Both FilmScene and the Englert reside in more than century-old buildings. Beautifully maintained and blessed with good bones, these facilities still require regular upkeep and renovation. **First-rate facilities are essential to keeping our artists and patrons happy.**

To ensure the longevity of our venues, our campaign includes strengthening FilmScene's flagship Ped Mall location and **a renovation and modernization of the historic Englert Theatre.** This quality upgrade, both center stage and behind the scenes, will improve audience experience, accessibility, and sustainability, and these improvements will enhance the lighting, sound, and stage production elements that deliver that all important nightly "wow."

FilmScene Expansion

As we celebrate our historic spaces, we also relish the opportunity to build a brand new arts facility for the next generation.

Purpose-built and state-of-the-art, a new three-screen facility at The Chauncey—in the heart of downtown—will become FilmScene's primary home. Commitment to ownership of the facility by our nonprofit will ensure organizational stability and guarantee that film as an art form has a secure future in Iowa City.

As a unique architectural gem, FilmScene at The Chauncey will be a landmark arts facility—the best of its kind in the Midwest. By setting a nonprofit arts organization as the cornerstone of a private investment, this partnership will open the building to the public and make our remarkable downtown even more welcoming.

A permanent home for cinema in the heart of downtown, our new facility will enhance and expand our organizational mission.

- Three new cinemas, seating over 215 total moviegoers
- Flexible space allowing for additional educational programming
- Programming expansion through increased show-times, community partnerships, and film offerings
- Cutting-edge digital picture and sound and the return of 35mm and 16mm film projection capabilities
- Enhanced in-theater comfort plus expanded food and drink options



Festival Investments

The future of our arts organizations begins with world-class venues. However, our success depends on more than bricks and mortar. To fulfill our promise, we must continue to develop innovative programs.

Some of our richest and most prominent programming is found in our festivals.

We will continue to nurture the Englert's two annual festivals: the literature and performance mainstay Mission Creek Festival and Witching Hour, a curious festival which explores the creative process.

And now, with expanded cinema facilities, FilmScene will create Refocus Film Festival, presenting films inspired by and adapted from original text—a unique film event for our City of Literature.

Arts Educational Initiatives

Our campaign is only worth pursuing if we truly feel there is an opportunity to **improve access and engagement with the arts for all people in our community.**

On stage and screen, we are endowed with amazing art. **To best leverage this remarkable programming for educational impact,** we seek to launch an arts education effort in collaboration with local partners to expand arts engagement in our community. Together, FilmScene and the Englert will hire a **Community Engagement Director**, dedicated to fostering deeper artistic connections with our local K-12 schools, universities and colleges, neighborhoods, and the diverse cultures of our community and to expanding year-round arts education workshops and artist visits to our schools.

Educational Initiatives

YEAR-ROUND ARTS EDUCATION WORKSHOPS

Building from the success of FilmScene's annual summer animation camp and the Englert's annual acting camp, the Englert and FilmScene will offer a curriculum of year-round education workshops in the arts for children and adults in our community.

ARTS PROJECTS IN OUR SCHOOLS

To ensure student engagement with arts experiences, the Englert and FilmScene are committed to bringing performances and filmmakers directly to students in their classrooms across our school district.

COMMUNITY ENGAGEMENT DIRECTOR

The Englert and FilmScene will hire a shared human resource. This community engagement director will be focused on bridging our programming with area schools, higher education, and the diverse communities of our area.

ALLIED ARTS NONPROFIT INITIATIVE

What began with an unorthodox but exciting idea of two organizations banding together for a single campaign can serve as a case study for a better-allied arts culture in this community.

The Englert and FilmScene will deepen important partnerships with the Bijou Film Board, SCOPE Productions, and other University of Iowa organizations and work with a collective of local cultural nonprofits to share ideas and best practices, work together, and envision a collective future for our entire region, starting here in Iowa City.

Englert Commissions

Musicians, artists, writers, photographers, and more are abundant within the Corridor, adding to the flavor of this Midwest oasis of art and culture. The Englert Theatre wanted to highlight this talent and began offering collaborative opportunities to local artists, commissioning projects to commemorate Englert milestones, our ever-supportive community, and the city we call home.

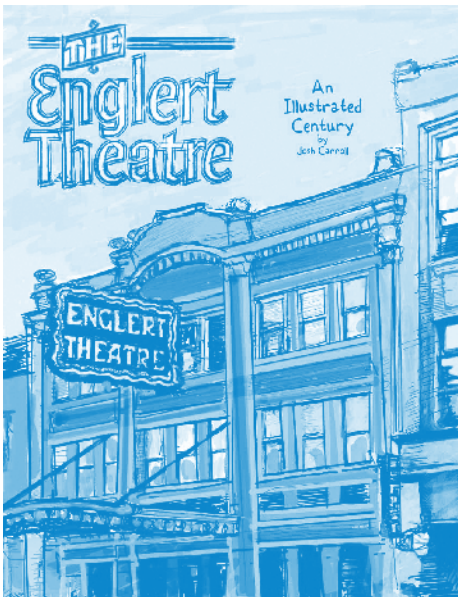


Iowa City Song Project

In celebration of its 100th birthday in 2012, The Englert Theatre commissioned 31 Iowan musicians and bands to write and record songs inspired by Iowa City. The result is the *Iowa City Song Project*, an album as diverse and cutting edge as the city itself. The album contains a spectrum of music from roots-rock to the avant-garde, bringing together a community of artists in a unique musical experience. Englert at 100

Englert at 100 showcases Iowa City-based photographer Sandy Dyas' celebration of the Englert's centennial year. Her photos document Englert show days from bus arrivals to post-performance loadouts. Dyas was given full access behind the scenes, capturing performers warming up in the dressing rooms and Englert staff working their offstage magic, creating an artistic documentation of the theater's identity.



An Illustrated Century by Josh Carroll

Local artist Josh Carroll was commissioned to create a comic book documenting a century of Englert Theatre history including its 1912 Vaudeville origins, movie theatre heyday, and performing arts center reincarnation. This richly-illustrated timeline provides an engaging way to connect with the past and trace the journey of Iowa City's last remaining historic theater.

Poetry by Dora Malech

In 2014, the Englert celebrated its 10-year anniversary as a nonprofit. Celebrations included special performances, dinners, and commissioned work from poet and former Iowa City resident Dora Malech. The Englert commissioned Malech to write original poetry for the anniversary, celebrating the theme of gratitude. Without the efforts and continuing support of the community, the Englert wouldn't exist as it is today, and we are forever grateful to our donors, sponsors, patrons, and volunteers.



ARTIST-IN-RESIDENCE 2014: Nat Baldwin

The Englert believes in supporting emerging and working artists and has created an Artist-in-Residence Program to allow artists time to work on their projects while experiencing and engaging with the Iowa Creative Corridor. Bassist/composer Nat Baldwin of the rock band Dirty Projectors was the first resident hosted in February 2014. Baldwin's residency included substantial time for him to work on new compositions as well as to engage with the Corridor community by conducting a songwriting workshop with students from Tate High School and visiting area cultural institutions with local artists.

Englert Beer Series

From Fall 2015 to Spring 2016, the Englert partnered with three local breweries to brew three original beers for the Englert Beer Series. Inspired by our past, present, and future, the original beers poured from the minds of brewers at Backpocket Brewing Company, Lion Bridge Brewing Company, and Big Grove Brewery. Backpocket's Riot of '84 Pre-Prohibition Lager was reminiscent of the beer likely made by John Englert at Iowa City's first brewery, and inspired by his hand in inciting the Beer Riots of 1884. Lion Bridge's Local Talent Robust Porter shines a spotlight on our mission of serving as a conduit between local and national scenes. Finally, Big Grove's Quantum Finish Hybrid-Style Double IPA is a funky beer aged in Cedar Ridge barrels with season citrus fruits, a true Corridor collaboration. Englert Beer Series beer may be available for purchase again in the future.

The Evolution of Bruno Littlemore

The Englert's first-ever, commissioned original stage play, *The Evolution of Bruno Littlemore*, premiered in Spring 2016. It's a story of evolution, biological and lingual. It's a story of love, across boundaries and species. It's a story of oppression, of inequality and colonialism. It's the story of Bruno Littlemore, an unusually intelligent chimpanzee. Presented in partnership with Working Group Theatre and New Territory Dance Company, the piece is based on the novel from recent Iowa Writers' Workshop graduate Benjamin Hale.

ARTISTS-IN-RESIDENCE 2016/2017: *Dis/Unity: A Service*

The Englert's Artist-in-Residence program hosted a group of artists for a week in Summer 2016 to workshop an in-themaking performance-based installation, *Dis/Unity: A Service*, which premiered before a live audience at the Deadwood Tavern, addressing trauma, liberation, and transcendence through sculptural installations and audience interaction. The final work premiered at the Englert in Fall 2017, and featured an ensemble of artists: Barber, Boubacar Djiga, Courtney D. Jones, Esther Baker-Tarpaga, Heidi Wiren Bartlett, Raquel Monroe, and Wendell Gray II. ■

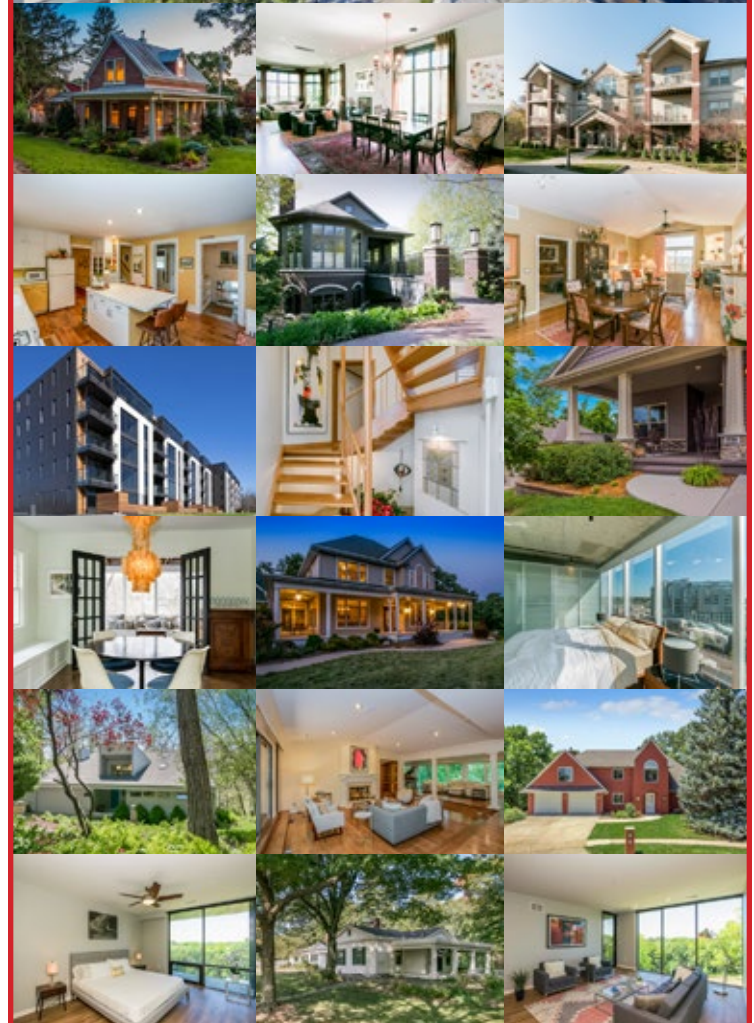

The History of the Englert

ON SEPTEMBER 26, 1912, husband and wife William & Etta Englert launched an institution when they opened The Englert Theatre in downtown Iowa City, replacing what had once been a livery stable. They built the theater to rival the finest stage and movie houses throughout the Midwest and to establish a vibrant community gathering space for local and regional citizens.

Vaudeville acts from across the world performed on the stage and films - still an emerging art form at that time - were shown on the theater's state-of-the-art projection equipment. These exciting events welcomed community members into the Englert's 1,071 seats. Above the theatrics in the main hall, William and Etta resided on the theater's second floor and provided housing for traveling artists on the third.

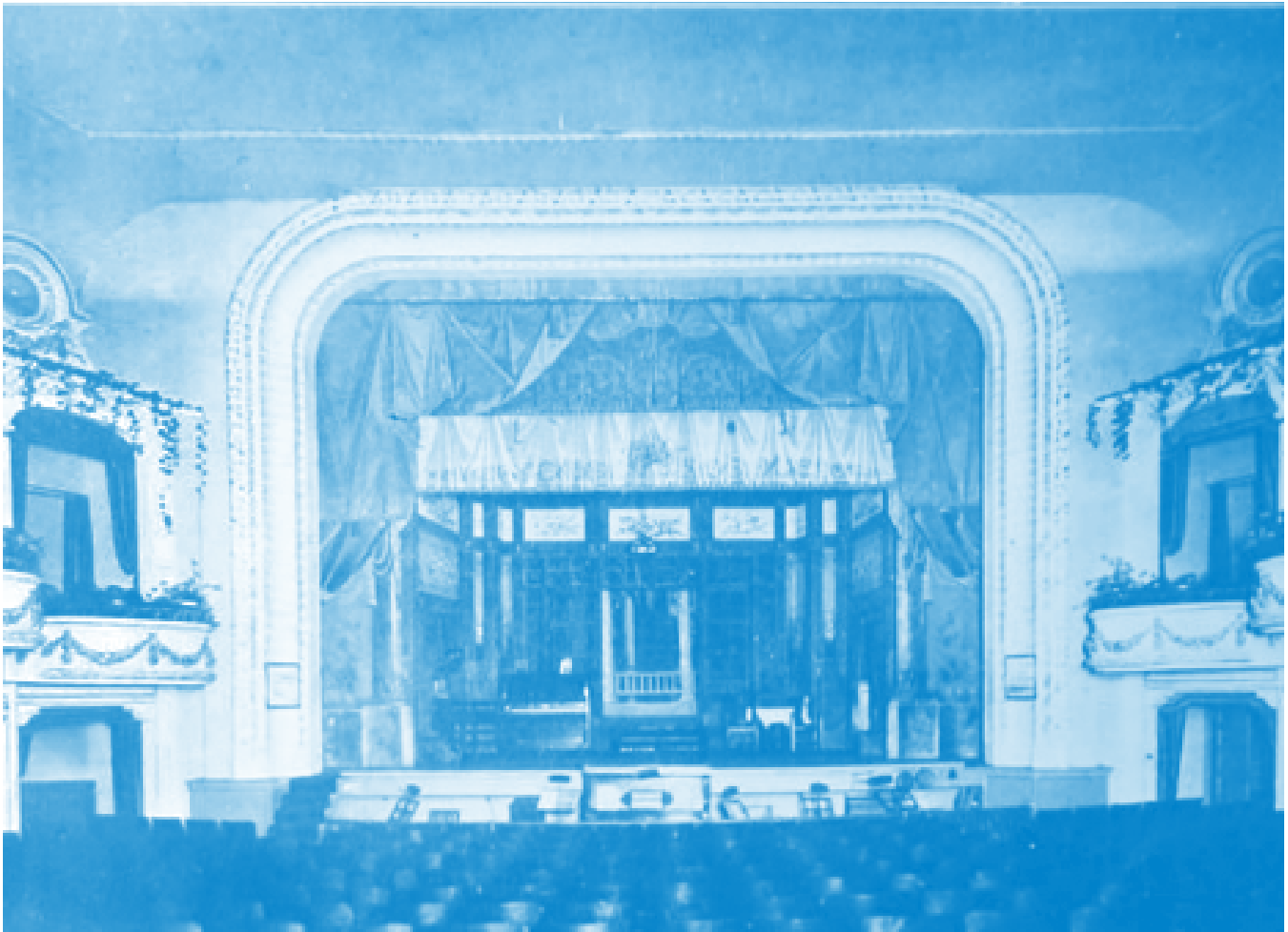
In 1920, William Englert passed away at 46 years old. Following his death, business partners A.H. Blank (from Des Moines) and Nate Chapman purchased the business in 1921. Chapman, who had been based in Des Moines, had moved to Iowa City just a year earlier when he and Blank purchased the storied Garden Theater cinema, which would later become The Varsity and then The Astro. The Blank and the Chapman families, through a line of committed descendants, would go on to steward the Englert's existence for the remainder of the century.

After Nate Chapman died in 1925, his wife Dora continued to own and operate the theater alongside A.H. Blank. Dora's brother, Al Davis, also assisted with managing the facility. On February 13, 1926, a fire nearly destroyed the Englert. Firemen fought to save the building as

the blaze tore through the roof. Dora Chapman was there - as was Etta Englert - and she would later recount the scene to her grandchildren - Nathan, Katherine, and Barbara Chapman.

Despite \$125,000 worth of damage to a property that had cost only \$60,000 to build 14 years before, the theater's benefactors restored the building with an eye to the ornate aesthetic tendencies of the 1920s. In particular, significant investment from A.H. Blank made this rebirth possible. From the ashes, the Englert returned to the Iowa City community.

In time, the venue became a full-time movie house. In the 1980s the singular theater space was subdivided into two small-screen spaces. Likewise the interior had been updated with gypsum board, paneling, carpeting, and acoustic

ceilings. The owners during this period were Ansel and Marvin Chapman (sons of Dora) and Mike Blank (son of A.H. Blank) of Central States Theater Corporation.

As the end of the century approached, Mike Blank, in his 90s, sought to sell the business while he was still alive. He conferred with his partners, the Chapmans (whose various family members had migrated away from the core of Iowa City), about selling the Englert. Seeking to honor Mike's wishes, the Chapmans agreed. In 1999, after nearly 80 years of caring for the building, they closed and sold the Englert.

A bar owner initially purchased the theater and planned to turn it into a club. However, a group of local citizens envisioned an opportunity to renovate and restore the theater to its original purpose: a performing arts and community

gathering space for the people of Iowa City. This group of inspired locals persuaded the City of Iowa City to purchase the theater and hold it in trust until funds could be raised for a newly formed nonprofit entity to purchase and renovate the space.

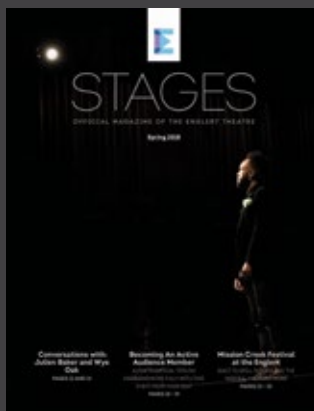
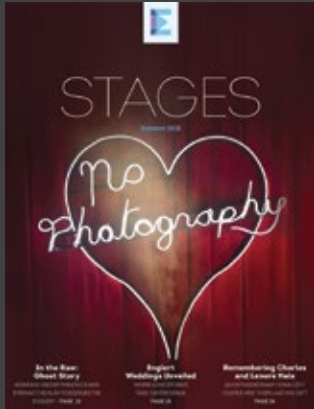
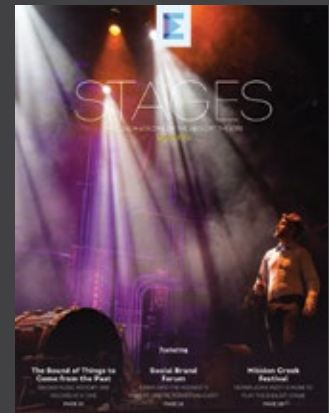
Over the next five years, this group worked diligently to rebuild the Englert as a premier arts venue and a hub in the Iowa City cultural scene. In part – under the banner of “Save the Englert” – the group secured funds to restore the Englert to its 1920's glory. The names of contributors are memorialized throughout the building: a capital campaign wall in the lobby, plaques around the theater, and on the backs of seats in the main hall.

On December 4, 2004, the Englert returned to the community with its first live performance in over 40 years. Since that time, the Englert has become

a leader in the Midwestern arts scene through its ongoing programming, partnerships with the community and the University of Iowa, its production of two innovative festivals - Mission Creek and Witching Hour, its commission work with local and international artists, its commitment to the preservation of history, and celebration of the evolving cultural diversity of the Iowa City area. ■

Audience Guidelines

In the age of lightning-fast entertainment that allows movies, music, and more to be downloaded in an instant to a smartphone, consumers may not be aware of how their technology and behavior can affect the concert-going experience for fellow audience members and for the performers themselves. The following guidelines need to be respected in order for all patrons and artists to have an enjoyable and safe experience. Please be courteous to those around you.

If you need assistance during the show, please go to your nearest volunteer usher. If additional assistance is needed, the usher will find the appropriate person to help you further.

Please arrive on time. We know parking downtown can be a hassle and our will-call lines can be long. Please allow extra time for travel, parking, and finding your seats. If you arrive late, we may ask you to wait until an appropriate break in the show to get you to your seats.

Do not have conversations, even whispering, during the concert or event. This will distract performers as well as fellow audience members. If your child becomes restless, frightened, or loud, please take him or her to the lobby.

Silence all cell phones, pagers, watches, and other devices. Don't text, tweet, blog, or surf the web. The glow from your device is distracting. You are here to enjoy the show, so please give the show your attention!

Keep feet, bags, and children out of the aisles. Blocking the aisles is against the fire code.

Pay attention to venue rules and posted notices. Many shows do not allow photography or recording. Flash photography is never allowed. If we ask you to stop, please do so.

Pay attention to the vibe of the show. If the crowd gets up and starts dancing, join them. Please don't try to do a one-person show for your own entertainment. We will ask you to sit down.

Respect the supporting act: You never know where they are going in the future. If you really dislike the music, take a walk or check out our current gallery exhibit on the second floor. Please be polite.

Patrons are never allowed on stage. Not before the show, during the show, or after the show.

Grounds for removal: If our staff finds you are not adhering to the above guidelines, we will give one verbal warning requesting that you change your behavior. If you continue to disregard the guidelines, we will request that you leave the premises. Being removed from more than one event will result in being banned from Englert-presented events for at least one calendar year. ■
